T. Hinz presented his water/sewer report. He also stated that he has checked into locks for the stations at the lake and they will run approximately \$12.00 each, with there being

64 locks needed and \$20.00 for each grinder pump. He feels the locks are needed to secure the pumps.

D. Nourse presented his highway report.

Sup Gozelski commended the highway department on a job well done. He rode down Sanford Road and the oil and stone job that was done was very good; there is no excessive stone so there was no waste.

D. Nourse explained that by doing oil and stone it saves the road for about 5 years. He also stated that they will be getting the trucks ready for winter soon. He priced a pump for the grader and it will be about \$1,500. He also stated that the 6 wheeler (truck #130) will need recaps until they decide what to do with it.

Coun Klein stated that no motion is needed for the above items needed and D. Nourse should purchase what is needed.

Sup Gozelski stated that the County has finished E. Center Road and they are working on View Road patching some bad spots. He stated that the county is doing a nice job. The Twin Bridge area will be closed for approximately another 4 more weeks as the railing still needs to be measured and built.

ZEO D. Swede gave a Dominion update. He stated GAI, a consultant company for Dominion, is putting in for a subdivision for the Randall property at the November Planning Board meeting. He stated that as of now, it is a private matter until Dominion takes control of the land, then it will become a public matter.

Coun Little stated that they are getting ready for the Open House at the Historical House on November 19 from 1PM-5PM.

D. Nourse stated that they are done with Norms truck and it can now be placed up for bid.

The amount of funding received has decreased each year for both the Town and the Youth Bureau. The Town will allow the Youth Bureau to receive the amount they would have received which would have been \$263.00.

Sup Gozelski stated that he spoke with Senator Gillibrand and Congresswoman Hochul about a week ago and requested information regarding federal funds, specifically the Great Lake Restoration Bill. Some funds will go into our Soil and Water fund at Wyoming County as it filters in from the Great Lakes Commission. Sup Gozelski chairs the Wyoming County Ag Committee and is on the Soil and Water Board of Directors and he is consistently telling the board how important Silver Lake is to the whole county.

Sup Gozelski also sits on the Rochester Transportation Board. The President of the Board wants to increase the transportation bond to over \$550 Billion to fix roads and bridges but they are not sure where these funds will come from.

The Agriculture Bill has been threatened to be decreased, Sup Gozelski has requested that this bill not be decreased.

Wyoming County passed a resolution asking the Governor to oppose Article X. Many counties in NYS are doing the same thing.

Sup Gozelski stated that NYSAC (NYS Association of Counties) holds meetings two times a year and that at the end of January they will meet in Albany to oppose Article X also. NYSAC is getting stronger and more support all the time from all sides.
