Sup. Gozelski called the meeting to order at 7PM

The Public Hearing to adopt the 2011 Budget for the Town of Castile was opened at 7:01PM.

No persons were present for or against the adoption of the budget.

Sup Gozelski stated that he feels it is a very good budget, and that very little of the fund balance will be used. He felt it was in the best interest of the Town to use as little as possible as they are looking out for the future.

Coun. Tarbell stated that he is still concerned about the pending issue with the \$5,000 increase that the Village is asking for the Fire Department for Fire Protection. He spoke with Mayor Granger and is going to meet with him again to discuss this further, but for now they will put the \$5,000 in the budget with the possibility of this cost being lowered.

J. Goodell, Wyoming County Dog Control Officer, was present to discuss the pending Licensing of Dogs within the Town of Castile. She explained that the Clerk's from all 16 towns within the county have worked for many months along with the County to come up with a unified dog law and fee. She stated that she has spoken with the State and that they were impressed with the Wyoming County Clerk's as no other County in the state is having a unified law.

J. Goodell has met with County Attorney Dadd several times for many hours to help prepare the law. The new law has done away with purebred licensing as the Clerk's felt that it will help to make things run more smoothly. J. Goodell is in agreement with this change even though she herself is a purebred license holder. She has run into many issues with people not being honest with the licensing of all of their dogs with this type of license.

R. Klein, a Castile resident, stated that he felt it discriminates against purebred license holders and that it shouldn't be held against him, as a purebred license holder, to have this omitted from the new law. He stated that with the new law it will more than double his fee to license his dogs.

Coun. Tarbell asked if J. Goodell could report back to the Town with any other issues that she may hear from other Towns as they are going through this process. She agreed that she would.
