Supervisor Gozelski called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

PUBLIC HEARING – 2010 PRELIMINARY BUDGET

The Supervisor declared the hearing opened at 7:01 PM. The Clerk read the notice of public hearing as published in the Perry Herald on October 22, 2009. No comments were heard in favor of or against the 2010 preliminary budget.

Brian Fleischman, Wyoming County Tourism Executive Director, would like to have a public forum at a future meeting about the historic aspects of Castile. A County-wide study will be conducted by a professor at SUNY Geneseo to show the best locations for viability for perspective entrepreneurs; the \$10,000 cost will be covered by IDA and Economic & Development. The Tourism office is working on a new website. When it is finished, we will have our website linked with theirs.

REGULAR MEETING, CASTILE TOWN BOARD, November 5, 2009, continued

Motion was made by Coun. Monteleone, seconded by Coun. Klein, resolved to authorize the Supervisor to sign the inter-municipal agreement between the County of Wyoming and the Town of Castile regarding the tractor with boom mower for the term of 12/1/2009 through 12/1/2024. This equipment is to be used within all sixteen towns in the County.

The Supervisor discussed the Village water supply with the Mayor. A contract has been signed to drill two new wells; 80 to 100 gallons a minutes from each well is needed. Money should be approved to put in 1¼ miles of water lines on View Road to Letchworth Park. After which Middle Reservation to Buffalo Street (at Rt. 39) paving can be completed.

Drainage work has started on East Lake Road (Perry Ave.) in the Village of Silver Springs by the bridge near the restaurant. The \$335,000 is

waiting to pave Weaver Road.

Time Warner has begun stringing more cable lines on the west side of Silver Lake.

Coun. Little reported that twelve members of the Castile Historical Society attended the opening reception for the exhibit of “Self Made Men & Women of WNY” at the Ontario Historical Society Museum and Research Center in Canandaigua. The display for Dr. Cordelia A. Greene was the largest at the exhibit. The members plan to return in February to see the Lincoln exhibit.

The Wyoming County Soil & Water Conservation Office held their annual awards dinner at Breezy Hill Party House in Warsaw on November 9, 2009. VanSlyke’s Dairy Farm, LLC was awarded Conservation Farm of the Year.

PWMS Kibler gave his sewer & water report. They are doing end of the season cleaning and checking of equipment.

Hwy Supt Foley discussed the drainage issue on Perry Avenue. A long term solution is being sought. Soil & Water Conservation Office is looking at the situation but that will be “slow going”. Foley was told to put an ad in the paper that no sand or salt will be handed out.

Motion was made by Coun. Monteleone, seconded by Coun. Little, resolved than any Town official be authorized to attend the NYS Association of Towns training school and annual meeting in New York City on February 14 -17, 2010 at Town expense.

The 2010 preliminary budget was discussed. The basic rate inside village will increase .0527% and the basic rate outside village will increase .0418%.
