They were not able to get hold of the engineering firm but would like to meet with them to upgrade their plan as it is about 20 years old. It would be more cost effective to go with this firm, as they are already familiar with it, rather than start at square one with another firm. Coun Klein stated that he would like to obtain a records writing grant to update the records.
