Supervisor Gozelski stated the Middle Reservation Road project has been delayed due to the rainy weather. Suit-Kote is looking at starting on July 20th weather permitting. The East Lake Road project had all the Right-of-Ways signed a month ago but then it changed to needing deeds signed and notarized. The deeds were completed as of today.

Bill Madison of Cornell Cooperative Extension received a grant to have classes the past six weeks at Camp Wyomoco. Some of the students attending the STEM Camp were from out of state. STEM stands for science, technology, engineering and math.

Coun. Tarbell has contacted Chris Mueller of Time Warner Cable regarding the special franchise agreement. Mr. Mueller will attend the September Board meeting.

Coun. Klein stated that the Silver Lake Watershed Commission held a special meeting on July 2nd to approve an \$18,000 quote from the Clark Patterson engineering firm for the dredging project at the Silver Lake outlet. They are hopeful that it will be done this fall.

Mary Kay Barton questioned whether any grants could be obtained through Stuart Brown.

Coun. Little read a report from Coun. Monteleone on updating the website . New photographs of the Town have been added and the Town Board minutes are now on the website. The calendar is being updated. The public is ask to start sending him pictures, meeting dates, and any other information that pertains to the Village and Town at his email address: sammonteleone@hotmail.com. Coun. Little told the Board that the Ontario County Historical Society Museum and Research Center will be hosting the national traveling exhibition "Self Made in America: Abraham Lincoln" for the month of February in 2010 which will only be seen in 40 institutions across the country. To complement this exhibit they will be presenting their own exhibition "Self Made Men and Women of Western New York" to be open from October 2009 to September 2010. Castile Historical Society submitted Cordelia A Greene's name, and she was chosen to be a part of this exhibition of 15 to 20 individuals.

PWMS Kibler gave his sewer report. He has had complaints of poor water quality – yellow water; he flushed the hydrants to help the situation.

Hwy Supt Foley gave his highway report.

Motion was made by Coun. Klein, seconded by Coun. Tarbell, resolved to authorize sealing Hathaway Road from Route 39 to Johnson Road, Slocum Road from Sanford Road to Town line, and second course on Sanford grind at a rough cost of \$48,500.00.

The Board will have the Town Assessor answer him in writing.
