Coun. Klein stated that it has been over a year since the issue with his property where a shed was placed too close to his property line. The zoning law states that it should have been placed 5' from the property line and it is closer than that. He also stated that

they paid \$250.00 for a survey to show where his property lines are so they could prove that the shed was placed too close. He felt he should not have had to spend the money to prove where his property line was and brought the bill to the Town and it was ignored.

R. Klein stated that he knows that the ZEO went with Mr. Fisher (the builder of the shed) at one point. He also stated that having the shed where it is isn't hurting them, but feels if it is within violation then it should be moved.

Coun. Klein stated that Dominion is planning on constructing a building to house a compressor on Randall's land. He stated that Dominion made an offer for this farmland to the Randall's in which they turned down, however, it is his understanding that Dominion is starting the process of eminent domain on this property. He stated that he does not understand how the State can say that NY, particularly Wyoming County, is losing farmland, when they are the ones that are taking or approving for this to happen. He said that this particular piece of land can grow any type of crop and is great farmland and that it is wrong that a company can come in and declare that they own the land. Coun. Klein stated that he spoke with Art Buckley and was told that our IDA was behind this project.

Coun. Monteleone requested that Coun. Klein keep the Board updated on this. Coun. Klein agreed that he would.

N. Kibler's water/sewer report was reviewed.

D. Nourse's highway report was reviewed.

D. Nourse stated to the Board that he would like to look into getting a larger excavator at some point.
