**PPA** **WHAT IS PPA?** Many of you have recently asked about the PPA line on the electric bill. This charge has always been on the bill, it's just that people are noticing it with the new billing format. PPA stands for Purchase Power Adjustment. We are allotted a certain amount of hydropower from New York Power Authority. Any amount over that allotment we have to buy on the open market as well as wheeling and other costs. These are prorated through the PPA charge on your bill.

**NEW LAW FOR PLAYGROUNDS** – A new law will go into effect on October 10, 2013 changing all playgrounds in New York State. This law prohibits smoking between sunrise and sunset when one or more children under age 12 are present.



**USDA RURAL HOUSING LOANS** – are available for very low-income rural residents who own and occupy a dwelling in need of repairs or need a loan to purchase a home. **Grants** for housing repairs are available for very low-income rural residents age 62 or older.
