**OFFICE CLOSED** – The Town and Village Offices will be closed on Friday, December 25<sup>th</sup> for Christmas. We will also be closed on Friday, January 1<sup>st</sup> for New Year's Day.



**NO PARKING** – on Village streets November 1<sup>st</sup> through April 1<sup>st</sup> between 1am and 7am. This allows our Public Works Department to handle snow plowing. Parking violators will be prosecuted by law and cars will be towed at owner's expense.



**DOG WASTE** – Please be sure your dog waste is securely bagged before putting it into the Village garbage cans.



**REMINDER!** Please do not allow your children to play on the gate on Chapel Street. It's not safe!



**A CHRISTMAS TEA** – The Bicentennial Committee will be hosting “A Christmas Tea” on December 6<sup>th</sup> from 2-4pm at the Castile Event Center. Tickets are \$10 each – available at area businesses as well as the Government Center.



**HEATING HELP** – If you're having trouble paying for heating this winter, the Heating Emergency Assistance Program (HEAP) may be able to help. Income limits are as follows: Household size 1 < \$2,244/month; Household size 2 < \$2,935/month; Household size 3 < \$3,625/month; Household size 4 < \$4,316/month. Contact the Office of the Aging or Social Services (585-786-8900) for more information.

**ENERGY EFFICIENCY REBATES** – are available through CEEP (Castile Energy Efficiency Program). All you need is your receipt, proof of Energy Star, and a completed application. Rebates are available for a range of appliances as well as lighting upgrades, including outdoor LED security lights. Pick up an application at the Village Office today!



**ELECTRICITY COST** – The U. S. Department of Energy has released the 2014 electricity rates for across New York State. While the average cost per kWh in the state was 19.7 cents, Castile electric customers pay only 6.1 cents per kWh.
