Brush and yard debris need to be kept separate or it will not be picked up. All yard debris will need to be put into biodegradable bags. No more than one pickup load of trimming per resident at a time. No trees will be picked up.



**SUMMER RECREATION** – will be held Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup> through Friday, July 31<sup>st</sup>. Recreation is **FREE** to anyone living in the Village or Town of Castile and runs from 9am –11:30am, except on Wednesday swim days. All children must have completed Kindergarten and be 14 years old or younger. You may pick up registration forms at the Government Center or at the Village Park during Recreation hours.
