SWIMMING POOL OWNERS – To avoid being charged for water usage on your sewer bill, please contact the Village Office with your water reading before and after filling your pool. Flip the cover on your new meter in your house to read it. If you need the Village to read the meter, there will be a \$10 service charge.



ELECTRICITY COST – The U. S. Department of Energy has released the 2013 electricity rates for across New York State. While the average cost per kWh in the US was 12.1 cents, and the average cost per kWh in New York State was 17.6 cents, Castile electric customers paid only 4.9 cents per kWh.



SUMMER RECREATION – will be held Monday, July 6th through Friday, July 31st. Recreation is **FREE** to anyone living in the Village or Town of Castile and runs from 9am –11:30am, except on Wednesday swim days.
