PPA **WHAT IS PPA?** Many of you have asked about the PPA line on your electric bill. This charge has always been on the bill. PPA stands for Purchase Power Adjustment. We are allotted a certain amount of hydropower from New York Power Authority. Any amount over that allotment we have to buy on the open market. The PPA includes this expense as well as wheeling and other costs. These are prorated through the PPA charge on your bill and will be higher during the winter months when more electric is being used.
