TOWN & VILLAGE OFFICES WILL BE CLOSED – on Monday, July 4th for Independence Day.

RATES for 2016-17 – The Sewer and Electric Rates will stay the same. The base Water Rate will increase by .48 cents for Village Customers which brings it to \$25.00 and the base Water Rate for Out of Village Customers will increase by .81 cent which brings it to \$42.00 a month.

VILLAGE WIDE YARD SALES – will be held on Saturday, June 4th.

CASTILE SILVER & GOLD will hold a baked-food and yard sale on June 3rd and 4th from 8:30-3:30 at 98 N. Main St.

BRUSH PICK-UP – will take place on the **third Monday of the month** through November – **one pass through Village, only**. Brush and yard debris need to be kept separate or it will not be picked up. All yard debris will need to be put into biodegradable bags. No more than one pickup load of trimming per resident at a time. No trees will be picked up.

SUMMER RECREATION – will be held Tuesday, July 5th through Friday, July 29th. Recreation is FREE to anyone living in the Village or Town of Castile and runs from 9am –11:30am, except on swim days. All children must have completed Kindergarten and be 14 years old or younger. You may pick up registration forms at the Government Center or at the Village Park during Recreation hours.

SWIMMING POOL OWNERS – To avoid being charged for water usage on your sewer bill, please contact the Village Office with your water reading before and after filling your pool. Flip the cover on your meter in your house to read it. If you need the Village to read the meter, there will be a \$10 service charge.
