FRIENDLY REMINDER- Property Owners please cut trees/branches that are blocking or hanging over sidewalks. Please keep your sidewalks clear of rocks, weeds and other debris in order to assure safe passage for all our Village's pedestrians. Also, no use of motorized vehicles on sidewalks. Thank you!

 **CASTILE LIBRARY** – will be closing early on July 3rd and will be closed July 4th. The free Summer Reading Program begins the first week in July-come in and sign up! The Red, White, and Done sewing program will be July 15.


 **UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST-** Monday July 10th will be the Women's Fellowship meeting at 11am. Thursday July 20th at 12 PM is Silver and Gold. Children's events this month include the one day Vacation Bible School *The Armor of God* on Saturday, July 29th and Youth Cooking Classes with Ellen LaCroix on Friday July 14, 21, and 28. Free adult coloring and coffee bar night on Wednesday July 26th 4-5:30p.m., adult coloring pages, markers/pens/colored pencils will be provided or bring your own.


 **BRUSH PICK-UP** – will take place on the 3rd Monday of the month, work load permitting, one pass through village only. ALL yard debris and brush need to be kept separate or they **WILL NOT BE PICKED UP**. Yard debris (leave, grass clippings, flowers etc.) need to be in a biodegradable bags. Brush- No more than a pickup truck load of brush at one time – 10' long, by 5' wide, 5' high roughly. Trees- the Village will NOT take or pickup any whole tree including the trunk, limbs, brush, or stump of a whole tree if you are cutting one down on your property.


 **VILLAGE PARK RESERVATIONS** – Don't forget about the Village Park for your family, graduation or church picnics this summer. Cost to reserve the park is \$125 per day for Castile Village/Town residents and \$150 per day for others. \$25 is refundable after the key is returned and the pavilion is inspected. Contact or stop by the Village Office to reserve your date.


 **SWIMMING POOL OWNERS** – To avoid being charged for water usage on your sewer bill, please contact the Village Office with your water reading before and after filling your pool. Flip the cover on your new meter in your house to read it. If you need the Village to read the meter, there will be a \$10 service charge.

POOL OWNERS - Please do not dump your pool water into your neighbor's yard without permission.

 **VILLAGE & TOWN OFFICE DROPBOX-** Customers are welcome to use our secure drop box located at the front of the office building. Village Clerk is also available 1st & 3rd Monday's of the month up until 6:30pm. Call JoJo at (585) 493-2233 x1006 to schedule arrangements.

 **ENERGY EFFICIENCY REBATES** – are available through CEEP (Castile Energy Efficiency Program). All you need is your receipt, proof of Energy Star, and a completed application. Rebates are available for a range of appliances as well as lighting upgrades, including outdoor LED security lights. Pick up an application at the Village Office today!

 **REMINDER!** Please do not flush anything but toilet paper. No wipes (not even the flushable kind), no sanitary products (including tampons). They get caught up in the pipes and cause backups in the sewer system. Thank you!

 **DOG LICENSE** -- New York State Law states that **EVERY DOG** owned or harbored in New York State for longer than **30 DAYS** must be licensed. Please bring current rabies certificate and proof of spay or neuter to license your dog at the Town Clerk's office. **REMINDER: PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG! SCOOP YOUR POOP!** Also please be sure your dog waste is securely bagged before putting it into the Village garbage cans.

 Please, **DO NOT BURN** your garbage in your backyard.
