VILLAGE AND TOWN OFFICES WILL BE CLOSED – on Monday May 29th in observance of Memorial Day.



We'll be **FLUSHING HYDRANTS** and operating valves on May 11th - watch for brown water.

RATES for 2017-18 – The tax rate will be increasing by approximately 3% per thousand. The Sewer and Electric Rates will remain the same. The base Water Rate will remain the same which includes the first 2,000 gallons. The water rate after the initial 2,000 gallons is increasing by 50 cents per 1,000 gallons being consumed for Village customers and 84 cents per 1,000 gallons being consumed for Town customers.

REMINDER TO ALL RESIDENTS – Please keep your sidewalks clear of rocks, weeds and other debris in order to assure safe passage for all our Village's pedestrians. Thank you!

BRUSH PICK-UP – will take place on the 3rd Monday of the month, work load permitting, one pass through village only. ALL yard debris and brush need to be kept separate or they **WILL NOT BE PICKED UP**. Yard debris (leave, grass clippings, flowers etc.) need to be in a biodegradable bags. Brush- No more than a pickup truck load of brush at one time – 10' long, by 5' wide, 5' high roughly. Trees- the Village will NOT take or pickup any whole tree including the trunk, limbs, brush, or stump of a whole tree if you are cutting one down on your property.

VILLAGE PARK RESERVATIONS – Don't forget about the Village Park for your family, graduation or church picnics this summer. Cost to reserve the park is \$125 per day for Castile Village/Town residents and \$150 per day for others. \$25 is refundable after the key is returned and the pavilion is inspected. Contact or stop by the Village Office to reserve your date.

SWIMMING POOL OWNERS – To avoid being charged for water usage on your sewer bill, please contact the Village Office with your water reading before and after filling your pool. Flip the cover on your new meter in your house to read it. If you need the Village to read the meter, there will be a \$10 service charge.

ENERGY EFFICIENCY REBATES – are available through CEEP (Castile Energy Efficiency Program). All you need is your receipt, proof of Energy Star, and a completed application. Rebates are available for a range of appliances as well as lighting upgrades, including outdoor LED security lights. Pick up an application at the Village Office today!



REMINDER! Please do not flush anything but toilet paper. No wipes (not even the flushable kind), no sanitary products (including tampons). They get caught up in the pipes and cause backups in the sewer system. Thank you!

PPA - WHAT IS PPA? Many of you have asked about the PPA line on your electric bill. This charge has always been on the bill. PPA stands for Purchase Power Adjustment. We are allotted a certain amount of hydropower from New York Power Authority. Any amount over that allotment we have to buy on the open market. The PPA includes this expense as well as wheeling and other costs. These are prorated through the PPA charge on your bill and will be higher during the winter months when more electric is being used.

DOG LICENSE – New York State Law states that **EVERY DOG** owned or harbored in New York State for longer than 30 DAYS must be licensed. Please bring current rabies certificate and proof of spay or neuter to license your dog at the Town Clerk's office. **REMINDER: PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG! SCOOP YOUR POOP!** Also please be sure your dog waste is securely bagged before putting it into the Village garbage cans.

Please, DO NOT BURN your garbage in your backyard.
