 **BRUSH PICK-UP** – will take place on the 3rd Monday of the month, work load permitting, one pass through village only. ALL yard debris and brush need to be kept separate or they **WILL NOT BE PICKED UP**. Yard debris (leave, grass clippings, flowers etc.) need to be in a biodegradable bags. Brush- No more than a pickup truck load of brush at one time – 10’ long, by 5’ wide, 5’ high roughly. Trees- the Village will NOT take or pickup any whole tree including the trunk, limbs, brush, or stump of a whole tree if you are cutting one down on your property.

 **VILLAGE & TOWN OFFICE DROPBOX-** Customers are welcome to use our secure drop box located at the front of the office building. Village Clerk is also available 1st & 3rd Tuesdays of the month up until 6:30pm. Call JoJo at (585) 493-2233 x1006 to schedule arrangements.

 **ENERGY EFFICIENCY REBATES** – are available through CEEP (Castile Energy Efficiency Program). All you need is your receipt, proof of Energy Star, and a completed application. Rebates are available for a range of appliances as well as lighting upgrades, including outdoor LED security lights. Pick up an application at the Village Office today!
