To: Residents and Property Owners of the Town of Castile Silver Lake Water District

Re: Silver Lake Water District Water Main Installation

The Town of Castile has awarded the Water Main Installation Contract to Randsco Pipeline Inc. of Macedon, New York. The Total Amount of the Contract is \$879,450.00.

The Contractor plans to begin the water main installation on March 27, 2017. The Contractor will start work along South Main Street (NYS Route 39) and then continue down Camp Road, Chapman Avenue, Locust Lane and Standpipe Road. Following the completion of water main installation, the contractor will begin work on the water booster pump station on Standpipe Road and three pressure reducing valve vaults.

The water main installation will be completed by August 1, 2017. We anticipate having the restoration completed during the summer of 2017.

This project will include the installation of water services to the road right-of-way for each house. Property owners will be responsible for connection to the water services and extension of the water services to their buildings. Property owners will also be responsible for internal plumbing changes.

An application for water service and an inspection fee paid must be submitted to the Town of Castile in order to connect to the new water main. The inspection of the resident portion of the water service will be completed by the Town of Castile during trench excavation, prior to the Town of Castile installing the water meter and transmitter. The water service installation and Town inspection can be completed at any time.

Prior to the installation of the water services Clark Patterson Lee will leave a white flag for you to place, near the right-of-way line of your property, in the location you would like your service installed. If you have already installed your water service, you will not need a stake.

Clark Patterson Lee is the Town of Castile's engineering consultant for the project.
