**BRUSH REMOVAL: ALL LEAVES MUST BE IN A BIODEGRADABLE BAG OR THEY WILL NOT BE PICKED UP!!!** Branches larger than 10" are not able to be chipped need to be in a bag. No more than one pick-up load per dwelling. Brush pick-up will be every 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday weather and workload permitting.



**VILLAGE PARK RESERVATIONS:** Got a graduation, family reunion, or church picnic coming up this summer? Cost to rent the park is \$125/day for Castile Village/Town residents and \$150 for all others. \$25 is refundable after key is returned and the pavilion is inspected.
