Sup Tarbell stated that the Town would have to petition NYSEG about getting a light down there.

M. Hotchkiss asked permission to hang purple ribbons on poles and mailboxes in the Town of Castile and also asked for the Town's support in proclaiming May as Color the Town Purple month.

Sup Tarbell stated that they should ask the homeowners to hang ribbons on their mailboxes and trees and that if there is a tree in The Town of Castile right of way she has permission to hang a ribbon from that.

M. Hotchkiss asked if she could hang ribbons from street signs.

Sup Tarbell stated that they are owned by the NYSDOT and they cannot be altered.

The Water/Sewer Report was reviewed. J. Drain was present and he stated that they finally got pump station 7 fixed which is the station that takes sewage away from the Charcoal Corral.

Sup Tarbell stated that everything has been running smoothly even though we have been shorthanded in help.

The Highway Report was reviewed.

Sup Tarbell stated that he has given Dep. Highway Superintendent D. Nourse a copy of all of the County's bids for fuel, crushed stone, etc. He also stated that the County has had discussions about replacing their shoulder machine at a cost of around \$80,000. He stated that the Town of Castile's share would be \$5,171.81. Sup Tarbell asked the Board if this was something we should consider investing in as right now the County helps us with our roads if we didn't have use of this machine we would have to rent one.

The Board all agreed that this is something we should consider doing.

Coun Hurst handed out the annual Fire/Rescue Squad Report. He also stated that he has been attending the meetings in Perry regarding their Comprehensive Plan and that the Town of Castile has had 1 meeting to work on ours.

Sup Tarbell stated that the survey for the Town of Perry is complete and that they are working on their Lake Survey.

Coun Vitagliano asked if the Board could start receiving reports from the Assessor. He stated that they receive reports from the Highway Department, Sewer Department and Zoning Department and it would be nice to see what is going on with the Assessor. Clerk Draper will speak with the Assessor regarding this.

Sup Tarbell stated that the next Building Committee meeting will be held on 4/15/13 at noon.

Coun Klein stated that the next Watershed Committee meeting will be held on 4/18/13 and doesn't anticipate any issues.

Sup Tarbell stated that he has had a couple of phone calls regarding the flag pole at the end of Chapel Street at the entrance of Grace Cemetery. The flag pole is broken.

The Board agreed that D. Nourse should purchase a new flag pole and flag and have it installed. The pole should cost approximately \$375.00 for a 20 foot pole. D. Nourse has also looked into having a new Rules and Regulations sign made for the cemetery which will cost about \$200.00.

A motion was made by Coun Klein, seconded by Coun Hurst for D. Nourse to purchase a new flag pole and flag and also a new sign for Grace Cemetery.
