J. Koch presented his Water/Sewer Report. He stated that he has implemented a new meter replacement program. He asked the Board members what their thoughts are regarding the riding lawn mower that is broken down at the shop.

Coun Monteleone stated that the last time he looked into purchasing a new motor for it would cost over \$1000.

D. Nourse stated that Matson's has a motor between \$500-\$600 that would get it up and running.

Coun Monteleone stated that for now they need to figure out what all is wrong with it and they should fix the

mower that we have now and we will look into purchasing a tractor at another time. In the mean time J. Koch and D. Nourse should start getting quotes to see how much a tractor would cost.

J. Koch stated that the pumps have been running extra hard because of the snow melting and all of the rain. He presented a copy of the chart from Pump Station 6 that demonstrates the amount of flow running through it for the last week and also a copy of what the chart looked like previous to the snow melting. He stated that this is an I&I problem and asked the Board if he could have Sewer Specialties come out with a camera and clean the lines. The cost would be \$3000 for a 10 hour day for 2 men. If there are breaks in the lines the patches to repair them cost \$1300 for a 8" X 24" and \$1500 for a 8" X 48".

Sup Tarbell stated that he spoke to Gail from the Perry office and she explained the billing process and that when the flow is that high it could cost us about \$8000 more for that quarter compared to when there isn't as much flow. He suggests that we have Sewer Specialties come out for a couple of days and see what they can get done.

Coun Monteleone asked if we have the money in the budget to do this.

Sup Tarbell stated that a couple of days will be fine.
