Sup Granger called the meeting to order at 1:05PM

R. Sceusa was present to discuss a drainage issue that he is having on his property. He resides on the corner of Chapman and Lakeside Ave. He stated that when the water flows from the hill coming from the top of Chapman after a heavy rain it washes the leaves and rocks into the grate and plugs it causing it to flood. He stated that he has spoke with Darryl and they would like to put a culvert in the ditch.

Coun Klein stated that he also observed the issues after a heavy rain and agrees that something should be done, and he recommended D. Nourse contact Soil and Water for a remedy as they have engineers that use formulas to figure the best plan of action.

D. Nourse stated that he has been in contact with Soil and Water and they have gone out to look at what the issue is.

Coun Vitagliano stated that we should follow the specs as set forth with Soil and Water.

D. Nourse stated that they are busy and it may take a month or more for them to get back to him.

D. Nourse presented the Water/Sewer Report. He stated that there had been 1 callout on July 5th for a grinder unit.

Coun Vitagliano asked if Darryl has been helping at the Water/Sewer department.

D. Nourse stated that he has helped some but most of the help has come from the Village of Perry and Village of Castile.

D. Nourse presented the Highway Report. He stated that he had a complaint regarding the signs on Chamberlain and Sowerby Roads. Currently the yield sign is on Sowerby and he feels it makes more sense to have it on Chamberlain Rd.

Coun Klein stated that it has always been that way and that he agrees with D. Nourse as he feels Chamberlain has more traffic.

A motion was made by Coun Klein, seconded by Coun Vitagliano to approve that a stop sign should be put up on both sides of Chamberlain Road and the yield sign removed from Sowerby Road.

Sup Granger stated that there has been talk at the County level regarding an increase

that the Town Highway Superintendents would like regarding the Ice/Snow Contract and the amount received per lane mile. Sup Granger stated that the County Supervisors were thinking of offering an increase of \$200 per lane mile. He pointed out that there may be a change in the zones. Currently there are 4 zones and they are looking into a possible decrease to 2 zones and he does not know where Castile will fall

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into this. The County will be doing a study from the last 10 years snow fall to determine this.

The Zoning Report was reviewed. It was mentioned that 1 property at Silver Lake has not responded to a violation letter regarding tall grass and an unlicensed vehicle and the County wanted to know how to proceed.

After a brief discussion it was stated that the Zoning Laws need to be looked at to see if the grass can be cut by the Town and then billed onto that property tax bill. If this is not allowable then the County is to contact the Town Attorney to start possible court proceedings.

The Assessors Report was reviewed.

The Board reviewed the results of the possible Old Orchard Beach water study that was consolidated by Clark Patterson Lee.

After a brief discussion the topic was tabled until Sup Granger can speak with a Clark Patterson Lee representative.
