D. Nourse stated that a towel was stuck in Pump Station 6 and that the ohms were running very high.

Coun Barber asked if the water reports have been in compliance.

The Highway Report was reviewed.

D. Nourse stated that Matt Jensen from the Village of Perry has resigned. He stated that he is not sure how far they had gotten with the shared camera/trailer agreement with the Town of Castile.

Sup Klein stated that D. Nourse needs to check with the Village of Perry before he purchases the trailer that is to be used for the camera.

D. Nourse stated that the filters are being changed each week at the Government Center because the duct work needs to be calibrated. He stated that he has contacted Harding Plumbing and the cost will be between \$1500-\$2000.

A motion was made by Sup Klein, seconded by Coun Hurst to hire Harding Plumbing to calibrate the duct work at a cost not to exceed \$2000.

T. McQuillen presented her Assessor's report. She stated that grievance was very quiet with only 2 people filing a grievance.

The Zoning Report was reviewed.

Sup Klein stated that he received the new Franchise Agreement from Charter Communication. He stated that previously they had promised to wire the areas that do not have cable but nothing ever came of it and that a lot of areas in the Town do not have cable.

After a brief discussion Clerk Koch was asked to forward the agreement to D. Kelly for his review.

Sup Klein presented the paver agreement with the Town of Perry. The cost is \$350,000 and \$100,000 needs to be put down (\$50,000 from Town of Perry and \$50,000 from Town of Castile). He stated that he is waiting to hear from the State if we can receive any money as part of the shared services agreement.

A motion was made by Coun Vitagliano, seconded by Coun Hurst allowing Sup Klein to sign into the shared services agreement with the Town of Perry for the paver.

D. Nourse stated that the Village of Perry and Village of Castile will not be charged for the use of the paver but any other municipality will need to pay. It was decided that an annual or semi annual contract should be drawn up for the rental of the paver to other municipalities.

An affidavit was received from Selective Insurance regarding the accident at the intersection of Route 39 and East Lake Road. Atty Kelly reviewed this and stated that

everything was in order for D. Nourse to sign it. The affidavit was to show that the Town of Castile does not own either of the roads and should not hold the Town at fault.

A motion was made by Coun Barber, seconded by Coun Hurst allowing Sup Klein to sign the letter of support for the Village of Perry to raise the bridge on Walker Road.
