The Water/Sewer Report was reviewed. Darryl Nourse stated that Dylan met with MRB Group and they looked at the Boost Station and determined that the 2 smaller pumps cannot keep up. Dylan will meet with Mark Walworth to fine tune the pumps.

Sup Klein stated that MRB Group has been doing a good job and that he thinks we should use them rather than CPL as an engineering group.

The Highway Report was reviewed.

The Assessors Report was reviewed.

The Zoning Report was reviewed.

Sup Klein stated that the Board has been reviewing the possibility of changing Pattridge Road from the intersection of Schenck Road to Hathaway Road to Beaumont Road as requested by L. Beaumont. He stated that the only people affected would be the Beaumont family as they are the only ones that reside on that portion of the road. He stated that the Beaumont family has been in Castile for a very long time doing farming and that B. Beaumont's grandfather was once the Town of Castile's Supervisor. Sup Klein stated that no cost would come to the Town and that the only reason this had not been approved was because he wanted to make sure that the Beaumont family approved this change as it would be a lot of work on their part changing all of their paperwork over.

B. Beaumont stated that he was fine with the change.

A motion was made by Sup Klein, seconded by Coun Barber to change the name of Pattridge Road from the intersection of Schenck to Hathaway to Beaumont Road.

Clerk Koch received an email from Zoning Officer Jenna Marley where she stated that they can no longer keep the zoning records at the County office as Don Roberts stated that they need to be kept in their own municipality. Clerk Koch stated that T. McQuillen took the file cabinet that housed the records as her file cabinets were full so now we will need to purchase a file cabinet for the zoning records.

Sup Klein stated that he will talk to Don Roberts and also see if they have a file cabinet that we can use. J. Brick stated that they have an extra one if we need it.

Coun Barber and Clerk Koch along with Dylan Nourse, Jeff Drain from the Village of Perry, Nate Osborn of Highbanks Dairy in the Gardeau water district and Steve Perkins from the Wyoming County Health Department (via phone) sat down to discuss the water issue at Highbank Dairy. N. Osborn stated that currently there are 2 water lines running to the farm, one is 2 inches and the other is even smaller. Currently they can't open the one line all the way because it will take away from the users behind them. What they would like to do is have a 6" main installed so that they can use the water that they need without having to haul some in.

S. Perkins stated that we should hold off and look into some other things first. He stated that Letchworth State Park may be interested in tying into our system. He said he will look into some other things and get back to us as he knows that this will be an expensive project.

Atty Kelly stated that he has heard that the Governor is looking to do a lot of infrastructure upgrades so there might be grants available.

Sup Klein stated that it will probably cost the municipality some money to do a study and hire an engineer.

Sup Klein stated that he spoke with Eleanor Jacobs from the Silver Lake Watershed Committee. She is looking to reevaluate the Mission Statement and readjust the responsibilities (who pays what). She also feels that they County should be more involved especially pertaining to the dredging that is being done.

J. Brick stated that he has reached out to S. Perkins but has not heard back. He did however, speak to the Planner from Livingston County, Angela Ellis and will reach out to her again to see if she can help.

Sup Klein stated that Atty DiMatteo is drafting something up and it may be presented at the next Silver Lake Watershed meeting on 1/21/2021.
