Supt's Report: We've been using our new zero-turn lawn mower. It has cut the park mowing time from 2 days down to 5 hours. We received the PESH report for electric. Work has to be done at the substation, Castile Agway, and Sun-Dor. Spring St will get oiled and stoned at the end of June/beginning of July. We are doing ditch work on East Park Rd. The State is still working on a study for speed reduction on 19A, but has said that likely nothing will be done until something is built up on the corner. The State will be resurfacing Main St within the next few years and will possibly do the sidewalks and drain work along Main St at that time. The sludge removal this year was 9 tons instead of 22 tons as in the past. The Board approved the purchase of wood chips for the Village Park playground.
