Committee Reports:

Tr Reed reported he came across grant money and totals for Wyoming County Municipalities for fiber b (NY Broadband Program).

Supt's Report:

Supt Wright reported that Sunday a transformer burned out.

There was a downed tree on Chapel St Wednesday.

EPS (Emergency Power Systems) is on the fritz.

A new Leaf Sucker is needed and the Supt will check Auctions International for possibilities.

Lover's Lane is finished until they can put Guard rails up in the spring.

A small building is needed for the Government Center to store the salt used here. It is currently eating a hole in the floor of the Fire Department. Supt Wright will look for options.

Buildings and Codes were out inspecting the premises. The shop has a few small matters to attend to.

MEUA Safety and Training is \$1,860.00/person for members. This is for yearly certification.

Supt Wright is consulting D. Roberts of Buildings and Codes to see what steps are necessary to re-do the bathroom in the Fire Hall.

There was a pole down in the Trailer Park at 117 S Main St.

Clerk's Report:

Monthly Zoning Report was submitted.

Resident N. Hesse owner of 40 E Park Rd, Castile requested a 200AMP Electrical Upgrade.
